CAMPANION APP

As mentioned in Mark's letter, we're excited to start using **Campanion** in 2022! This CampMinder app will allow families and staff to access their CampInTouch account via smartphone to register for camp, complete/submit online forms, upload documents, get push notifications from camp, see all picture albums from the summer, send one-way emails to campers, and access summer blog posts. While using Campanion isn't required for camp families and staff, it should certainly streamline the process of preparing for camp and also be an great platform for viewing pictures from the summer. Campanion has facial recognition capabilities, but only if a parent decides to activate it. If not activated, facial recognition won't be used for an individual. We will be sending more information on how to access and utilize the Campanion app when we send the Family Handbook in January. Stay tuned.

In case you missed the announcement earlier this fall, we have news to share about the Micah head counselor team. As with everything in life, change is inevitable and after seven years as Camp Micah's Girls' Head Counselor, **Shari Idelson** will be stepping down.
